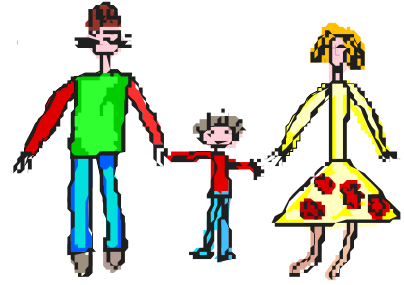




Would you like to make a difference?

We are looking for families who have children with special needs to share their story with students who are preparing to be teachers and doctors. These informal visits are a chance to talk about your experiences with the education or medical system – what works, what doesn't. What you would like or need from a teacher or doctor. Here, families are the teachers and experts.



Visits last about two hours. You are free to set the time, place and what you will do together with students. It might be an informal meeting in the living room, a family dinner, or playtime in the park. Host families are asked to complete an evaluation of the visit and provide feedback to students.

Families interested in becoming a part of Families as Faculty are required to attend Host Family 101. This two hour workshop is designed to help make your student visits a success. Workshops are held in Albuquerque, Silver City, Las Cruces, Farmington, Gallup, Santa Fe and Portales in the fall and spring.
